Nutrition for Learning:

- **Direct delivery program: we bring food to the school. You apply and the application is reviewed by the ministry that funds the program. IF approved, you're allocated money based on several factors for use at school based on need, population, socio economic factors.**
 - **Direct delivery program – takes away the need to budget within the ministry's guidelines and avoid stockpiling, and over ordering.**
 - **Two visits: 1 for start-up (could be more than one until the coordinator is comfortable with the program), 2nd visit for**
 - **Ordering is online, you don't have to place an order every week.**
 - **Must meet with your resource officer twice a year**
 - **Must meet public health points.**
 - **Must fundraise to involve the program at the school.**
 - **As of right now, there is no specific amount that needs to be fundraised.**
- **Applications are reviewed in April, the program would start in September of 2020.**
- **School would need a POC as Coordinator who Resource Consultant would go to and be in contact with.**
